Product Overview

Update 2 for RTX64 3.3 is the latest update to the 64-bit version of IntervalZero's market-leading hard real-time RTX64 3.3 software product. Update 2 for RTX64 3.3 can be downloaded [here](#).

Release Highlights

- Improves subsystem performance on systems that support Memory Bandwidth Allocation (MBA) and Cache Allocation Technology (CAT).

Features and Resolved Issue

- Resolves an issue where the Subsystem failed to start on INTEL Skylake i9 X Series systems. (6573)
- Resolves an issue where the Subsystem caused a Blue Screen on INTEL Xeon scalable processors. (6572)
- Improves subsystem performance on systems that support Memory Bandwidth Allocation (MBA) by implementing a dedicated RTX64 bandwidth. (6577)
- Improves subsystem performance on systems that support Cache Allocation Technology (CAT) by allocating RTX64 L3 cache from a non-system-wide shared cache. (6577)
- Resolves an issue where the Subsystem would crash on Symmetric Multiprocessing (SMP) systems when RTX64 Structured Exception Handling (SEH) logic was stressed. (6327)
- Resolves an issue where the Virtual Network NDIS driver did not handle all states and caused an intermittent Blue Screens. (6179)
- Resolves intermittent issues where the Virtual Network would become disconnected or stop working after Windows updates were applied. (5916)

- Resolves an issue where the RT-TCP/IP Stack would prevent Windows from shutting down. (6605)

Activation & Licensing
